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Prayer: Writ Petition, filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the 1st respondent to order an enquiry to be undertaken by a high profile, Hones Officer attached with the CBCID Department on the strength of the petitioner's representation dated 09.08.2023 which has been sent as against the custodial violence / torture committed by the respondent Nos.5 to 7 against the petitioner's husband Arujunan and his brother Arumugam and proceed further in accordance with law.

ORDER

The matter is posted under the caption "For Reporting Compliance." The learned Government Advocate submitted that the report could not be served on the petitioner. However, this Court, vide order dated 18.02.2026 directed the defacto complainant to submit an application under the Right to Information Act, and the respondents were directed to consider the same in accordance with law. It is now reported that the petitioner submitted an application. However, the same was rejected by the Additional Superintendent of Police, CBCID, Chennai, vide order dated 02.04.2026. The contention of the petitioner is that he is entitled to a copy of the report, but the respondents have rejected the request. Since the case is posted before this Court only for reporting compliance, this Court is not inclined to adjudicate upon the issue as to whether the petitioner is entitled to a copy of the report.
