ORDER

The learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submitted that the second respondent was employed with the petitioner Bank. On allegations of misappropriation, disciplinary proceedings were initiated against him, and upon completion of the enquiry, he was dismissed from service by order dated 30.06.2016.

2.Aggrieved by the order of dismissal, the second respondent filed W.P.No.32543 of 2022 before the Principal Bench of this Court. Subsequently, the said Writ Petition was dismissed as withdrawn on



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05.07.2024. Thereafter, the second respondent preferred an appeal before the Appellate Authority under the Tamil Nadu Shops and Establishments Act with a delay. The said appeal was also withdrawn. After a lapse of several months, the second respondent filed a fresh appeal before the Appellate Authority under the Tamil Nadu Shops and Establishments Act. The Appellate Authority entertained the appeal and allowed the same. Challenging the said order, the present Writ Petition has been filed.

3.Considering the prima facie case made out by the petitioners, there shall be an order of interim stay of the operation of the impugned order until further orders.

4.Mrs.K.R.Shiva Shankari, learned counsel for State accepts notice for the first respondent.
