3. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that the Court Amin along with police officials came to the office of the petitioner for attachment on 05.03.2026 and that the petitioner is ready to deposit the entire award amount before the concerned Court.

4. Issue notice to the second respondent returnable by 30.03.2026. Private notice is also permitted.

5. The petitioner is directed to deposit the entire award amount to the credit of M.C.O.P.No.84 of 2021 on the file of the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal / Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ramanathapuram and on such deposit, the Executing Court is directed not to proceed till 30.03.2026.

6. Post the matter on 30.03.2026.
