“It is now informed that since there is a UDR mistake, the matter has been forwarded to the District Revenue Officer, who is the competent authority to rectify the defect. Therefore, both the parties i.e, the petitioner and the respondents 6 to 14 who are represented by counsels shall appear before the District Revenue Officer, Pudukkottai on **11.11.2024** and the authorities shall ensure all the files are placed before the District Revenue Officer. The District Revenue Officer, Pudukkottai after holding an enquiry, shall proceed to pass orders within a period of one (1) month thereafter and report compliance to this Court. Compliance can be reported by the parties by way of filing a memo. Since both the parties are represented by their respective counsels, separate notice need not be issued by the District Revenue Officer informing the date of enquiry. ”
