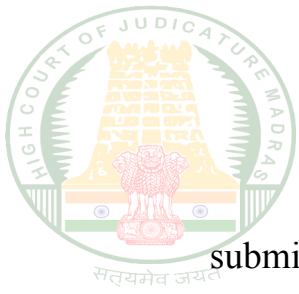
PRAYER :-

Second Appeal filed under Section 100 of Civil Procedure Code, to allow the Second Appeal and call for the records and set aside relating to the Judgment and Decree passed by the Learned Sub-Judge, Kuzhithurai in A.S.No. 29 of 2019 dated 26.04.2024 confirming the Fair and decretal order of the Learned Principal District Munsif, Kuzhithurai in E.A.No. 65 of 2017 in E.P.No. 18 of 2014 in O.S.No. 210 of 2006 dated 17.12.2018 and thus render justice.

ORDER

Mr. M.R. Sreenivasan, learned counsel for the first respondent,



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submitted that the appellant, being the obstructor aggrieved by the concurrent findings of the Executing Court, has preferred the present appeal. He further submitted that, though the matter had been adjourned for reporting settlement, settlement talks are presently underway between the original judgment-debtor and the decree-holder, and therefore sought accommodation to report the outcome of the same.

2. The learned counsel for the appellant, however, submitted that he has no instructions regarding any settlement having been arrived at and going on between the decree-holder and the judgment-debtor.

3. Be that as it may, it appears that the judgment-debtor has also undertaken to negotiate with the obstructor with a view to giving a quietus to the dispute. Hence, post the matter on 08.07.2026.

4. The interim order already granted by this Court is extended till then.
