PRAYER :-Civil Revision Petition filed under Article 227 of The Constitution of India to set aside the order dated 12.08.2025 passed in I.A.No. 2/2025 in G.W.O.P.No.27/2025 by the Learned Family Court, Madurai and grant the interim custody of two minor children named G.R.Anbuselvan (aged 13 years) and G.R.Rakshitha (aged 10 years) to the petitioner.

ORDER

Mr.R.Gandhi, learned counsel takes notice for the respondent.

2.The petitioner is the mother of the children, who had filed G.W.O.P. for custody of her children, in which the learned Judge also



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met the children, who have expressed their discomfort with their mother.

The mother being the natural guardian of the children is entitled to have the visitation right. But however, in view of the statement recorded by the learned Family Judge, it would be appropriate that the mother has visitation right over the children before the Family Court, Madurai, in the presence of the child counsellor available there.

3.Considering the age of the children, any order permitting them to have a visit during the week days would affect their school. Hence, the respondent/father is directed to produce the children on 25.10.2025, 08.11.2025 and 22.11.2025 at 2 P.M and permit the mother to be with the children without any interference in the presence of the child counsellor. The child counsellor shall file a report before this Court regarding the said visitation before this Court on or before 26.11.2025.
