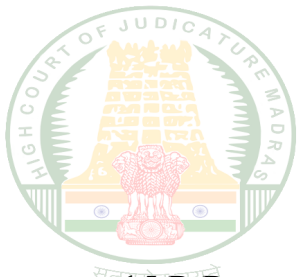

ORDER

2. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners as well as the learned counsel appearing for the respondents 1, 3 to 9 and 17 to 19.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the respondents 1, 3 to 9 and 17 to 19 would submit that they are having objections, but they have not specified any objections.



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4. Considering the facts and circumstances and taking note of the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioners, this Court is inclined to condone the delay, but on terms. Hence, this petition will be allowed on payment of cost of Rs.2,000/- (Rupees Two Thousand only) by the petitioner, to the Madurai Bench of Madras High Court Advocates Welfare Fund [Indian Bank High Court Branch, Madurai, Current Account No.7087208431, IFSC IDIBI000H040], on or before 13.02.2026, failing which, the petition shall stand dismissed automatically.
