ORDER

This writ petition has been filed challenging the proceedings of the second respondent dated 18.07.2025 and consequently, to direct the respondents 2 and 3 to restore the patta in the petitioner's name, based on the registered sale deed bearing Document No.7322 of 2023, dated 26.10.2023 registered in the Thirupparankundram Sub Registrar Office.

2. When the matter was taken up for hearing, it was brought to the notice of this Court that the writ petitioner had already sold the subject property on 12.02.2024. However, the said fact was neither disclosed in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition nor brought to the notice of this Court during the course of arguments advanced on behalf of the petitioner. The said fact was brought to the notice of this Court by the learned counsel for the fourth respondent.

3. In view of the suppression of material facts and in view of the fact that the petitioner is no longer the owner of the subject property, this Court is not inclined to interfere with the order passed by the second



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respondent. Accordingly, the writ petition stands dismissed. No costs.

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Consequently, the connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
