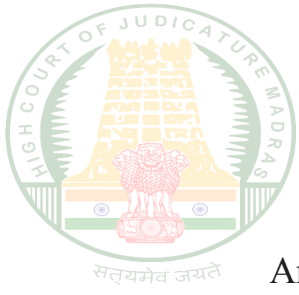

No.39/1D1, 39/2A1, 39/2A2 and 25/8B in Abhiramam Village, Kamuthi Taluk, Ramanathapuram District, within a time frame as stipulated by this Court and pass any other appropriate order or relief as this Honble Court may deem fit.

ORDER

An order dated 26.09.2025 is challenged on the ground that the order was issued without notice to the petitioner and without taking into consideration the cancellation of the Will executed in favour of Miner Raja.

2. Learned Additional Government Pleader accepts notice for the first respondent.

3. Since a *prima facie* case is made out, the Tahsildar is restrained from effecting any further changes to the revenue records until the next date of hearing.

4. Issue notice to the second and third respondents returnable on 06.01.2026. Private notice is also permitted.
