Prayer : Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of a Writ of Mandamus directing the respondents to take necessary steps to demarcate, sub-divide, lay survey stones and thereby earmark the lands in respect of the pathway/public road passing through S.Nos.25, 27/9, 31/1, 2, 3, 4,37/1, 2A and 38/2C, 2B connecting the

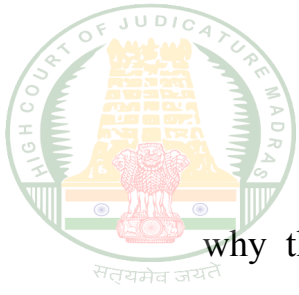

ORDER

The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that though the Village Map shows a pathway from the main road, the said land was neither surveyed nor the entire extent of the road was laid and only a part of the road from the main road was laid.

2. The learned Special Government Pleader appearing for the respondents would submit that there must have been objections from the patta land owners.

3. As seen from the Village Map, if the road is not laid, there would be no access to several patta lands. It is for the Tahsildar to explain as to

why the road has not been laid and the land has not been surveyed pursuant to the representation made by the petitioner.

4. Therefore, post the case on 20.01.2026. The third respondent, namely the Tahsildar, shall be present in person before this Court on 20.01.2026 to explain the issue.
