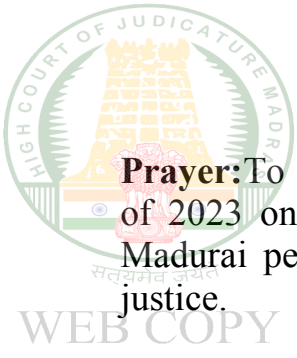

Prayer: To Stay the operation of the Award dated 10.07.2025 made in MCOP No.659 of 2023 on the file of the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Special District Judge, Madurai pending disposal of the above Civil Miscellaneous Appeal and thus render justice.

ORDER

(Order of the Court was made by the Hon'ble **G.K.ILANTHIRAIYAN J.**)

Issue notice to the respondents returnable by four weeks. Private notice is also permitted.

2. There shall be an order of interim stay on condition that the petitioner shall deposit entire award amount along with proportionate accrued interest and costs to the credit of M.C.O.P.No.659 of 2023, on the file of the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Special District Judge, Madurai, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, failing to deposit the said amount within the stipulated time, this miscellaneous petition shall stand dismissed automatically, without any further reference to this Court.

3. On such deposit being made, the major claimants are permitted to withdraw 50% of the deposited amount as per the ratio of apportionment made by the Tribunal, by making necessary application before the Tribunal. The Tribunal shall deposit the share of the minor claimants in any one of the Nationalized bank in a Fixed Deposit initially for a period of three years and renewable thereafter, till the minors



attain majority. The mother of the minor claimant is permitted to withdraw the accrued interest once in three months directly from the bank.
