ORDER

This Civil Revision Petition has been filed challenging the order made in IA No.3 of 2025 in COS No.19 of 2024 dated 23.10.2025 on the file of the Principal Sub Court, Pudukkottai.



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2.The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the respondent made supply of goods to one M/S.Virgo Polymers Company for a sum of Rs.39,78,595/- and the petitioner being the Sales Manager had executed an acknowledgment of debt, dated 17.06.2021, in favour of the said company, admitting to settle a sum of Rs.25,00,000/- to the respondent. On the basis of such acknowledgment, M/S.Virgo Polymers Company has filed a suit in C.S.No.83 of 2022 before this Court for recovery of money and the present suit, namely, COS.No.19 of 2024 has also been filed by the respondent for recovery of money. He would further submit that for recovery of money, two different suits have been filed, which is an abuse of process of law.

3.Issue notice to the respondent returnable by 28.01.2026. Private notice is also permitted.

4.Post the matter on 28.01.2026. There shall be an order of interim stay till then.
