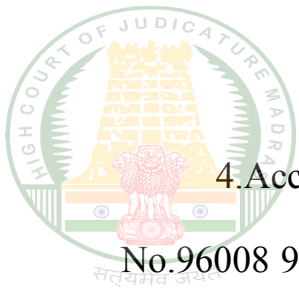

ORDER

This Civil Revision Petition has been filed challenging the Fair and Decree order made in IA No.12 of 2025 in OS No.64 of 2013 on the file of 1st Additional District Judge, Trichirappalli, dated on 24.10.2025.

2. Issue fresh notice to the second respondent returnable by 17.02.2026. Private notice is also permitted.

3. Despite service of notice to the respondents 1, 3 and 5 and their names have also been printed in the cause list, when the matter is taken up for hearing today, there is no representation on behalf of the respondents. Therefore, this Court thought it fit to appoint a Legal Aid Counsel for the respondents 1, 3 and 5.



4. Accordingly, this Court appoints Mr.Jeyaprakash, (Enrol.No.4129/2024, Mobile No.96008 98154) as Legal Aid Counsel for the respondents 1, 3 and 5 to assist the Court.

The High Court Legal Services Committee attached to this Bench shall pay a sum of Rs. 5,000/- to the said “Court appointed legal aid counsel” towards remuneration.

5.The learned counsel for the revision petitioner is directed to serve copies of the papers to the Court appointed Legal Aid Counsel for the respondents 1, 3 and 5.

5.Registry is directed to print the name Mr.Jeyaprakash, as Court appointed legal aid counsel for the respondents in the cause list.

6. M/s.S.Amutha Bharathi, learned Court legal aid counsel for the respondents 6, 10, 11, 13 and 14 would submitted that there would be a contra interest with regard to the appearing on behalf of the sixth respondent.

7. Accordingly, Registry is directed to print the name of M/s.S.Amutha Bharathi as Court appointed legal aid counsel only for respondents 10, 11, 13 and 14 in the cause list.
