The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is agreeable to appoint two members of Pasipattinam village among committee members of Arulmighu Easwaran Temple situated at



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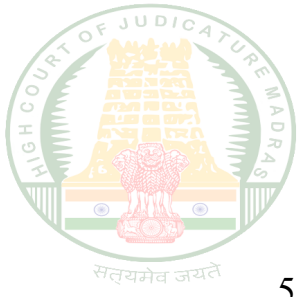
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Kaliyanagari Village, if the villagers of Pasipattinam village appoint two members of the petitioner's village i.e., Kaliyanagari Village among the committee members of Arulmiughu Pasiyamman Temple and the said arrangement may be recorded and appropriate orders may be passed.

2. In this regard, the petitioner is directed to file an affidavit to the effect that the villagers of Kaliyanagari Village will have no objection to appoint two members of Pasipattinam Village among the committee members of Arulmighu Easwaran Temple, which is situated in Kaliyanagari Village, provided that two members of Kaliyanagari Village are appointed as committee members of Arulmiughu Pasiyamman Temple situated at Pasipattinam village.

3. The learned counsel appearing for the fourth respondent would submit that the cost of renovation of Arulmiughu Pasiyamman Temple would be more than one crore rupees.

4. In reply, the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is ready and willing to contribute the amount.
