ORDER

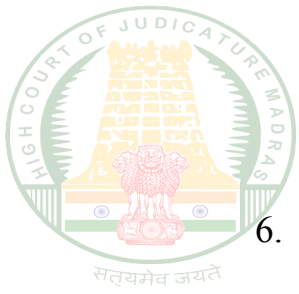
This Civil Revision Petition is filed to set aside the fair and decreetal order dated 01.08.2025 passed in I.A.No.2 of 2025 in O.S.No.182 of 2021 on the file of the learned Additional District Munsif, Kumbakonam.

2. The learned Counsel appearing for the revision petitioner submits that notice sent to the first respondent returned with an endorsement “no such person”. Private notice also ordered and proof not filed.

3. The learned Counsel appearing for the revision petitioner further submits that the first respondent has participated in the trial and evaded the service of notice.

4. Issue fresh notice to R1 returnable by 19.02.2026. Private notice is also permitted.

5. Despite service of notice to the second respondent and his name has also been printed in the cause list, when the matter is taken up for hearing today, neither the respondent No.2 nor any counsel representing him appeared before this Court. Therefore, this Court thought it fit to appoint a Legal Aid Counsel for the respondent No.2.



6. Accordingly, this Court appoints M/s.Meenakshi Babu, Enrol.No. 3350/2024, Mobile No.96298 77006) as Legal Aid Counsel for the respondent No.2 to assist the Court. The High Court Legal Services Committee attached to this Bench shall pay a sum of Rs.5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only) towards remuneration to the legal aid counsel appointed by the Court for the respondent No.2 for conduct of the case.

7. The learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to serve copies of the papers to the Legal Aid Counsel for the respondent No.2.

8. Registry is directed to print the name of M/s.Meenakshi Babu, as Legal Aid Counsel for the respondent No.2 and Mr.P.Thambidurai, the learned Government Advocate for the 5th and 6th respondents in the cause title.

9. Post the matter on **19.02.2026**.
