By way of this application, a prayer has been made for re-calling the order dated 15.06.2026, in terms whereof, the petition was dismissed for non-prosecution.

Learned counsel for the applicant/ petitioner has submitted that he was unwell and on account whereof he could not attend the Court. He further submitted that he had requested a learned colleague of his to make an appropriate mention before the Court, but unfortunately, he was stuck in traffic. He submitted that as the non-appearance before the Court was bonafide and not intentional, the application be allowed by re-calling the order of dismissal for non-prosecution.
