COPC No.255 of 2026

By way of the present petition, a prayer has been made to initiate the contempt proceedings against the respondents for willfully and intentionally disobeying the judgment dated 10.11.2025, passed by this Court in CWP No.16507 of 2025. Vide judgment dated 10.11.2025, the following directions have been issued :-

“3. Having regard to the nature of aforesaid innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioner, this Court sees no necessity to call for reply on behalf of respondents and deems it fit to dispose of the present petition with a direction to respondent No.1 to consider and decide the pending appeal (Annexure P-3), which has been filed by the petitioner against the order dated 14.02.2023, whereby petitioner has been suspended after inquiry, expeditiously, preferably within four weeks from today. Ordered accordingly. Needless to say, authority concerned, while doing the needful in terms of instant order, shall afford an opportunity of being heard to the

petitioner as well as other stake holders and pass appropriate orders within stipulated time. Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.”

As per submissions made by learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, those directions have not yet been complied with, by the respondents. In such situation, before proceeding further, let Court notices be issued to the respondents, returnable for **08.05.2026**, on taking steps within three days.
