**OMP No. 34 of 2020**

By way of instant application filed under Section 80(2) CPC, leave has been sought from this Court to file the suit without serving notice under Section 80(1) CPC.

For the reasons stated in the application, which is duly supported by an affidavit, this Court is of the view that no prejudice, if any, would be caused to either of the party if applicants/plaintiffs are permitted to institute the accompanying suit without serving any notice under Section 80(1) CPC. Otherwise also such notice is only required to be issued to non-applicant/defendant No. 27. Accordingly, the application is allowed subject to just exceptions and applications/plaintiffs are exempted from issuing any notice under Section 80(1) of the CPC before instituting the accompanying suit. Application stands disposed of.

**OMP No. 31 of 2020**

For the reasons stated in the application, which is duly supported by an affidavit, same is allowed. Application stands disposed of.

**CS No. 5 of 2020**

Notice. Mr. Sudhir Bhatnagar, learned Additional Advocate General waives notice on behalf of the State. Issue separate notices to defendants No. 1 to 26, returnable within six weeks, on taking steps within one week.

**OMP No. 32 of 2020**

Notice in the aforesaid terms. Reply if any, on or before the next date of hearing. In the meantime, parties are directed to maintain status quo qua the nature and possession of the suit property.

**OMP No. 33 of 2020**

The application is disposed of with the direction that the applicants would file the translated documents in issue by the next date of hearing.
