

**Parshotam Singh v. State of Himachal Pradesh and Anr.****CrMMO No. 198 of 2026**

By way of instant petition, prayer has been made by the petitioner for quashing for FIR No. 121/2022 dated 16.6.2022, registered at Police Station Indora, District Kangra, Himachal Pradesh, under Section 420 of IPC as well as consequent proceedings, on the basis of compromise, whereby parties have resolved to settle their dispute amicably inter-se them.

Though with a view to substantiate factum of compromise, petitioner has placed on record compromise deed, but with a view to ascertain genuineness and correctness of the compromise placed on record, this Court deems it fit to cause presence of respondent No.2 in the Court on the next date of hearing. Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes to cause presence of the petitioner as well as respondent No.2 on the next date of hearing, enabling this Court to pass appropriate orders.

List on **25.3.2026**, on which date, parties shall remain present in the court. In the meantime, respondent-State may also ascertain factum with regard to compromise, if any.
