Prima facie, it appears from the order (Annexure P-5) that the pay of the petitioner was fixed on notional basis which means that no payment was made to him. Thereafter, an order was passed on 2.1.2026 (Annexure P-6), holding that ₹41,702/- was paid in excess without mentioning the detail of the actual payment made. Therefore, in these circumstances, the respondents are restrained from recovering the amount mentioned in the order dated 2.1.2026 (Annexure P-6), till further orders.

Reply, if any, be filed within three weeks and rejoinder thereto, be filed within two weeks thereafter and the matter be listed before the Bench having Roster.
