

Kewal Singh Negi vs. Baldev Singh Shandil

By way of present application, applicant/petitioner has prayed for suspension of sentence passed against him.

Applicant/petitioner was convicted by the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Solan, District Solan, Himachal Pradesh, in Criminal Case No. 51/3 of 2018, titled, ***Baldev Singh Shandil vs. Kewal Singh Negi***, vide judgment dated 18.03.2025 and vide order of the same date he has been sentenced to undergo simple imprisonment for a period of one year and further to pay compensation of ₹3,85,000/- in favour of the respondent and in default of payment of compensation, petitioner was ordered to undergo simple imprisonment for further period of one month.

The appeal preferred by the petitioner has been dismissed vide judgment dated 17.11.2025, by

the learned Sessions Judge, Solan, District Solan, Himachal Pradesh.

Since, the revision petition filed by the petitioner has been admitted and the same is likely to take some time for final adjudication, it is ordered that the substantive sentence imposed upon the petitioner shall remain suspended till next date of hearing on the following terms :-

- *The applicant/petitioner shall deposit 30% of the compensation amount in addition to the amount, which he has already deposited within a period of six weeks from today and in case the compensation amount is not deposited as ordered, the interim order shall stand vacated.*
- *The applicant/petitioner shall furnish personal bond in the sum of ₹20,000/-, along with one surety of the like amount, to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court, within a period of six weeks from today, with an undertaking that he will surrender before the learned trial Court to serve the sentence, in case of ultimate dismissal of his revision petition by this Court.*
- *The applicant/petitioner shall not leave the territory of India without the prior permission of this Court.*
