By way of instant petition filed under Section 528 of the BNSS, 2023, prayer has been made by the petitioner for quashing of FIR No.0187 of 2025 dated 19.08.2025, under Sections 281 and 125(a) of the BNS, 2023, registered at Police Station Paonta Sahib, District Sirmaur, Himachal Pradesh, as well as consequent proceedings pending before the Court below on the basis of amicable settlement arrived inter se parties.

Though compromise placed on record suggests that parties have resolved to settle their dispute amicably inter se them but this Court with a view to ascertain the genuineness and correctness of the compromise, deems it fit to summon respondents No.2 to 4 for the next date of

hearing, so that factum with regard to compromise placed on record is ascertained.

List on **23.03.2026**, on which date, respondents No.2 to 4 shall remain present in Court. Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes to cause presence of respondents No.2 to 4 on the aforesaid date. Dasti notice on usual terms, if required. In case, petitioner takes steps for Dasti notice, same be handed over to the petitioner within two days thereafter.

Learned Additional Advocate General is also directed to verify the aforesaid factum of compromise, if any.
