Ms. Vishali Lakhanpal, learned counsel for the petitioner(s) in Cr.MMO Nos. 377 and 378 of 2025 submitted that these petitions have arisen out of FIR No.106, dated 22.7.2024, registered at Police Station Barotiwala, District Solan, H.P., whereas, Cr.MP(M) No. 273 of 2026 had arisen out of the application filed under Section 156(3) of Cr.P.C. and these were wrongly ordered to be tagged.

Mr. Sudhir Thakur, learned Senior Counsel, assisted by Mr. Karun Negi, learned counsel has stated that on the last date of hearing, the statement was made mistakenly by him that these matters have arisen out of the common FIR. The record of these files shows that the statement made by Ms. Vishali Lakhanpal, learned counsel for the petitioners in Cr.MMO Nos. 377 and 378 of 2025 is correct. Hence, in these circumstances, Cr.MMO Nos. 377 and 378 of 2025 are ordered to be de-linked from Cr.MP(M) No. 273 of 2026.
