Learned vice counsel for the respondent has placed on record copy of office order dated 23.03.2026, wherein it has been mentioned as under:-

"In compliance with the judgment dated 11.03.2026 passed by the Hon'ble High Court in CMP(M) No. 55 of 2026 and LPA No.129 of 2026 titled HRTC versus Balwant Singh, and in exercise of the powers conferred under Rule 39 of the CCS (Leave) Rules, 1972, approval is hereby granted for payment of cash equivalent to leave salary for 83 days of un-availed Earned Leave in favour of Sh. Balwant Singh. Superintendent G-II (Retd.) HRTC Head office Shimla. The said leave pertains to the period from 29.01.1987 to 20.11.1989 and shall be paid at the rates admissible under the relevant rules."

Confronted with this, learned counsel for the petitioner states that other retiral benefits have not been granted to the petitioner, in terms of the judgment dated 24.08.2024, passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court.

Learned counsel for the respondent is directed to comply with the judgment in its letter and spirit within a period of two weeks.
