When this case was taken up for consideration, learned Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he has instructions to state that there is a station available where the petitioner can be accommodated and interest of justice would be served, in case, the petitioner is permitted to make such a representation and till decision on the representation, the petitioner is allowed to continue at the present place of posting.

2. In light of the prayer made by learned Counsel for the petitioner, this writ petition is disposed of without interfering with the impugned transfer order but with the observation that if the
