Heard. This application has been filed on behalf of the appellant/applicant wherein he seeks condonation of a delay of 105 days, as has occurred in the institution of the appeal before this Court. The reasons' constraining the appellant/applicant, to, omit to file an appeal within time are adnauseam portrayed in paragraph 3 of the application, contents whereof are duly supported by an affidavit. A categorical disclosure exists therein, of, bureaucratic processes necessarily required to be undergone, for finalization of an opinion for instituting an appeal against the impugned award, hence consuming time, for the necessary sanction/approval, being meted by the competent authority, for filing, of, an appeal, against, the impugned award, before this Court. Therefore, with the apposite averments portraying good, sufficient and adequate cause, whereupon the appellant/applicant was constrained to omit to file an appeal, within time, before this Court, thereupon the delay in the filing of the appeal stands satisfactorily explained, hence, it is condoned. The application stands disposed of.
