Notice. Mr. Kulbhushan Khajuria, Advocate, appears and accepts service of notice on behalf of respondent.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions, states that petitioner is ready and willing to pay the entire amount of compensation awarded by the learned Court below within two months. He states that sum of Rs.35,000/- out of total compensation of Rs.1,75,000/- already stands deposited with the learned trial Court, which can be ordered to be released in favour of the respondent/bank.

Since petitioner is ready and willing to pay the entire amount of compensation awarded by the learned Court below, coupled with the fact that some amount, as detailed hereinabove, has already been deposited with the learned trial Court, this Court this deems it fit that till the next date of hearing, judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 02.05.2025 awarded by the learned Court below shall remain suspended. Ordered accordingly.

However, remaining amount shall be deposited within two months as otherwise undertaken to be deposited,

failing which this Court shall have no option but to decide the petition on its merits.

List on 25.05.2026. In the meantime, sum of Rs. 35,000/- lying deposited with the learned trial Court is ordered to be released in favour of the respondent-complainant, by remitting the same in its bank account, detail whereof, shall be furnished within a period of one week, if not already furnished.
