The applicant/petitioner has filed the present application for staying impugned orders dated 20.02.2026 (Annexure P-7) and 28.02.2026 (Annexure P-8), whereby the applicant/petitioner who was working with the respondents and discharging the duties as Clerk, has been withdrawn and directed to report for further duty to the Adda Incharge, HRTC, Una.

As per averments made in the application, the applicant/petitioner has been discharging clerical duties in the office of respondent No. 3 without any interruption, however now vide office orders dated 20.02.2026 (Annexure P-7) and 28.02.2026 (Annexure

P-8), her clerical duties have been withdrawn and she has been deployed on actual duties i.e. on the post of Conductor.

Since the applicant/petitioner had been discharging the duties clerical in nature, she has carved out a prima facie case in her favour. Therefore, it is ordered that she shall be permitted to perform the duties as has been discharged by her before issuance of impugned orders dated 20.02.2026 (Annexure P-7) and 28.02.2026 (Annexure P-8), by the respondents, which orders shall also remain stayed, qua the petitioner only.

Reply, as prayed, be filed within four weeks.
