In this case, the suit of respondent Amar
Nath was dismissed by the learned trial Court, vide
judgment dated 01.12.2022 and in appeal, those findings
have been reversed by the learned First Appellate Court,
by awarding the following relief :

*“36. In view of my finding on point No.1
above, both the appeals are allowed and
Civil Suit No.924/1 of 2021/12, titled as
'Amarnath versus Vidya Devi & Others' is
decreed and defendants are restrained from
causing interference over the suit land
comprised in Khasra No.218min, Khewat
No.52min, Khatoni No.108min, measuring
0-16 bighas situated in Village Berthin
Pargna Sunhani, Tehsil Jhandutta, District
Bilaspur, H.P. and civil suit No.923/1 of
2021/13 titled as 'Vidya Devi vs. Amar Nath
and others' is dismissed. The judgment be
placed on each of the file. Decree-sheet be
drawn up accordingly.”*

The said findings have been assailed by way
of the accompanying appeal, in which, the show cause
notice has been issued to respondent–Amar Nath. In such
