



Sushil Kumar & Others versus Abhishek Jain & Others

While deciding CWP No.15600 of 2025, this Court has passed the following order:

“4. Having regard to the afore-submissions, but without examining the merits of the matter, this writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents/competent authority to consider and decide the aforesaid representation of the petitioners in accordance with law as well as taking into consideration the above judgment in the case of Inder Singh Thakur within a period of six weeks from today. The decision so arrived at shall also be communicated to the petitioners.”

Admittedly, the said order has not been complied with, which has been passed in the presence of learned Additional Advocate General.

In such situation, notices are ordered to be issued to the respondents. Mr. H.S. Rawat, learned Additional Advocate General, appears and waives service of notice on behalf of the respondents. The respondents are directed to file response by explaining as to when the matter has been put up before them and what action has



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been taken by them till date, positively by or before the next date of hearing.
