



**Manjeet Singh & Another versus Abhishek Jain &
Others**

While deciding CWP No.18843 of 2025, this
Court has passed the following order:

“3. Consequently, in view of the above, this Court without going into the merits of the case deems it fit to dispose of the present petition with a direction to the respondents to consider and decide the pending representation (Annexure P-4) of the petitioners expeditiously, preferably within a period of six weeks in light of Inder Singh case (supra). Ordered accordingly. Needless to say, authority concerned, while doing the needful in terms of instant order, shall afford an opportunity of hearing to the petitioners and pass a speaking order thereupon. Liberty is reserved to the petitioners to file appropriate proceedings in appropriate court of law, if they still remain aggrieved. Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.”

Admittedly, the said order has not been complied with, which has been passed in the presence of learned Additional Advocate General.

In such situation, notices are ordered to be issued to the respondents. Mr. H.S. Rawat, learned Additional Advocate General, appears and waives service of notice on behalf of the respondents. The respondents



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are directed to file response by explaining as to when the matter has been put up before them and what action has been taken by them till date, positively by or before the next date of hearing.
