

**CHANDER PAL @ AASU @ MAJNOO AND OTHERS Versus
STATE OF HP AND OTHERS**

By way of instant petition filed under Section 528 of Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, prayer has been made on behalf of the petitioner for quashing of FIR No.144 of 2011 dated 02.07.2011 under Sections 420, 120-B and 201 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Sadar, District Bilaspur, H.P., as well as consequent proceedings, if any, pending adjudication before the court below on the basis of amicable settlement arrived *inter se* parties.

Though with a view to substantiate the factum of compromise, petitioners have placed on record compromise deed (Annexure P-3), perusal whereof reveals that respondent No.4 has decided to resolve the matter *inter se* parties, but with a view to ascertain the correctness and genuineness of the compromise, this Court deems it necessary to call for a status report and secure presence of respondent No.4.

Mr. Rajan Kahol, learned Additional Advocate General, appears and accepts service of notice on behalf of

respondents No.1 to 3. He prays for and is granted one week's time to file status report.

Learned counsel for the petitioners undertakes to cause presence of respondent No.4 on the next date of hearing, enabling this Court to pass appropriate orders qua prayer made in the instant petition. Since petitioners have undertaken to cause presence of respondent No.4 in the Court, there is no necessity to issue notice to him.

List on 30.03.2026. Learned Additional Advocate General is also directed to verify the aforesaid factum of compromise, if any.
