

**Pushap Lata Vs. State of H.P. & Ors.
CWP No. 3703 of 2026.**

The grievance of the petitioner is that despite having completed more than six years at GSSS Bagshar, Tehsil Karsog, District Mandi, H.P., she has not been transferred out of the said station and posted in District Kangra, where the petitioner intends to be posted in light of the fact that her husband is serving at Dharamshala and her is a couple case. It is further the contention of the petitioner that she has a medical issue as she has a cyst in her brain and, therefore, transfer to District Kangra would give her the benefit of being with her family, who can look after her, in case of any emergency.

In light of the fact that the petitioner is stated to have completed six years at GSSS Bagshar, Tehsil Karsog, District Mandi, H.P., prima facie it appears that the rejection of the representation of the petitioner is not sustainable because it cannot be the case of the Department that there is not even a single post available in District Kangra, where the petitioner can be adjusted.

Learned Deputy Advocate General to have instructions as to where best the petitioner can be adjusted in light of the fact that her is a couple case and further she has a medical issue.

List on **22.04.2026**, as prayed for. Let needful be done, in the meanwhile. Authority to take into consideration the stations mentioned by the petitioner in the writ petition, where, as per her, she can be adjusted, while imparting instructions.
