

Deepanshu Dhiman Vs. State of Himachal Pradesh and Others.

Inter alia submits that the petitioner got married with detenu-Mehak Sharma on 04.11.2025 in the Santoshi Mata Mandir, Har Kukar, Tehsil Ghumarwin, District Bilaspur, Himachal Pradesh.

2. It is submitted that the said detenu has been taken away by her parents from respondents No.4 and 5 on account of the fact that it is an inter-caste marriage and she is a major having been born on 07.10.2007. The photographs of the proof of marriage, date of birth and aadhar card etc., as such have been appended. It is also submitted that the respondents have also been approached but of no avail.

3. Notice. Mr. Varun Chandel, learned Additional Advocate General, appears and waives service of notice on behalf of respondents No.1, 2 and 3-State.

4. Issue notice to respondents No.4 and 5, returnable within two weeks, on taking steps within one week.

5. In the meantime, counsel for respondents No.1, 2 and 3-State shall ensure the presence of detinue alongwith respondents No.4 and 5 on the next date of hearing.

6. Accordingly, the proceedings are deferred for **01.04.2026.**
