This writ petition has been filed for grant of following substantive reliefs:-

- a) That kindly issue a writ of Certiorari quashing and setting aside the order dated 07.11.2025 whereby compensation of ₹1,17,500/- has been illegally sanctioned and disbursed in favour of respondent No.6.
- b) That kindly issue a writ of Mandamus directing the respondents to recover the illegally disbursed compensation amount from respondent No.6 in accordance with law.
- c) That direct the respondents to conduct an independent inquiry against the concerned Patwari, Kanungo and other revenue officials who prepared and verified the false damage report.
- d) That direct the State authorities to initiate departmental and disciplinary proceedings against the erring officials responsible for preparing false reports and releasing compensation illegally.
- e) That direct the respondents to produce the complete original revenue file and CM Seva

f) That restrain the respondents from granting any further compensation or financial benefit to respondent No.6 in respect of the disputed property til final adjudication of the civil dispute.”

2. After arguing for a while, learned counsel for the petitioner sought permission to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to avail appropriate remedy as may be available to the petitioner for redressal of her grievances.

3. Granting such liberty, petition is dismissed as withdrawn. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
