CMP No.5522 of 2025

This application has been filed by Sub-Divisional Officer [Civil], Ghumarwin, District Bilaspur, Himachal Pradesh, seeking permission to use school ground of Government Senior Secondary School [Boys] Ghumarwin, District Bilaspur, for sport and cultural activities to be held from 05.04.2025 to 09.04.2025, during which '*Garishma Utsaav*' fair/festival is going to be held in Ghumarwin.

2. It has been submitted by Learned Deputy Advocate General that Sub-Divisional Officer [Civil]/Sub-Divisional Magistrate, is Chairman of '*Garishma Utsaav*' Fair Organizing Committee.

3. It has been stated that there is no alternative ground available for conducting cultural and sports activities during the fair, except the playground of school, referred, supra.

4. It has been submitted by Learned Deputy Advocate General that sports activities cannot be said



the activity in conflict with the education rather that it is part of education and further that cultural programme of fair is going to be organized from 05:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. and, therefore, there will be no disturbance in school premises and studies of students on account of cultural programme.

5. It has been submitted that similar permission with identical facts and circumstances has already been granted vide order dated 28.03.2023 for conducting '*Garishma Utsaav*' from 05.04.2023 to 09.04.2023.

6. We are, therefore, persuaded to allow this application and permit the applicant to organize sports and cultural activities on the occasion of '*Garishma Utsaav*' fair/festival, w.e.f. 05.04.2025 to 09.04.2025 in the premises of Government Senior Secondary School [Boys] Ghumarwin, District Bilaspur, Himachal Pradesh, on the following conditions:-

- (i) That no damage shall be caused to the property of the school and its playground, where the event is proposed to be organized;
- (ii) That after event is convened, the playground shall be handed over to the Principal of the School in neat and clean conditions;



- (iii) That the law and order shall be maintained by the local administration during the said period; and
- (iv) That the applicant shall deposit a sum of Rs.10,000/- [Rupees Ten Thousand] in the Students Welfare Fund of the school.

Application is allowed and disposed of accordingly.

CMP No.5647 of 2025

This application has been filed by one Achhar, seeking permission to organize sports activities i.e. wrestling competition on 20.04.2025 in the playground of Government Senior Secondary School Bhaderwar, Tehsil Sarkaghat, District Mandi, Himachal Pradesh, to promote the local rich culture and to encourage as well as promote wrestling.

2. Alongwith application, Resolution No.134 passed by School Management Committee in its meeting has been placed on record, which meeting was attended by applicant as Member of Committee. His name figures at Serial No.15 of Annexure A-1. In resolution, it was decided to organize the wrestling in school playground after seeking permission from High Court. It has further been stated in the Resolution as well as in application that this wrestling competition is being organized since last 60 years.



3. It has been further submitted that in view of topography of village and non-availability of any other suitable ground, there is no other alternative, except to organize wrestling competition in the school playground.

4. School Management Committee has no objection in allowing the competition as the day on which it is going to organize is Sunday and there shall be no disturbance in the studies or school activities on that day and, therefore, the applicant being Member of School Management Committee has approached the Court.

5. We are, therefore, persuaded to allow this application and permit the applicant to organize wrestling competition on 20.04.2025 in the premises of Government Senior Secondary School Bhaderwar, Tehsil Sarkaghat, District Mandi, Himachal Pradesh, on the following conditions:-

- (i) That no damage shall be caused to the property of the school and its playground, where the event is proposed to be organized;
- (ii) That after event is convened, the playground shall be handed over to the Principal of the School in neat and clean conditions;
- (iii) That the law and order shall be maintained by the local administration during the said period; and



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- (iv) That the applicant shall deposit a sum of Rs.20,000/- [Rupees Twenty Thousand] in the Students Welfare Fund of the school.

Application is allowed and disposed of accordingly.
