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The applicant is Sports Cultural and Welfare Association, Ghana-Hatti, Tehsil and District Shimla. It is a registered Society. It seeks permission of this Court to organize sports activities like Inter-State Wrestling Matches and Volleyball and other sports and cultural activities on 2nd June, 2019 in the open ground of Government Senior Secondary School Ghana-Hatti. It is averred that it being Sunday, the school shall remain closed and as such, no disturbance shall be caused to the academic atmosphere of the school. It is also explained that the applicant-Organization has been organizing events for the last around 60 years or so.

Having regard to the fact that the event is proposed to be organized on Sunday when the school shall remain closed, learned Additional Advocate General submits that there will be no violation of the directions issued by this Court.

For the aforestated reasons, the application is allowed and the Sports Cultural and Welfare Association,
