

**Chandan Singh v. State of Himachal Pradesh
& Others**

CWP No.3882 of 2015

Grievance is that the petitioner was appointed as Trained Graduate Teacher [Arts] on 28.05.2012, on the basis of a resolution dated 23.05.2012, passed by School Management Committee in Government Senior Secondary School Paban in Tehsil Chopal in District Shimla. After joining service, the petitioner passed the teachers eligibility test on 25.08.2012 [Annexure X-4]. It is averred that petitioner worked as TGT [Arts] in aforesaid school but the Authorities issued an Advertisement on 28.08.2015 [Annexure X-5] for filling up the post of TGT [Arts] on which, the petitioner was working with the intention to replace the petitioner by fresh hands and this action was arbitrary and illegal.

2. Learned Proxy Counsel Ms. Bheeshamlata, submits that since the petitioner was continuing in service, therefore, interim orders were passed on

14.09.2015, directing the Respondents not to dispense with the service of the petitioner.

3. Faced with above situation, Learned State Counsel, as prayed, is permitted to have fresh Instructions, as to whether the petitioner had remained in service from 28.05.2012 till passing of interim orders on 14.08.2015 and whether the petitioner had worked after passing of interim order and the present status/incumbency, if any, be also furnished to this Court.

4. Let necessary Instructions be furnished and matter be listed on **09.09.2026**.
