On pressing for the interim relief, it is brought to our notice by the State that an FIR No.178 of 2024 dated 17.07.2024, under Sections 420,465, 468, 471, and 120B IPC, PS Sadar, Hamirpur, HP, is pending against the present petitioner. Accordingly, we prepone hearing from 03.06.2026.

2.                      Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not wish to press the present petition with liberty to file afresh on the same cause of action with better particulars.

3. Accordingly, the writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid. Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
