By way of instant petition, prayer has been made by the petitioner for quashing of FIR No. 15 of 2022 dated 16.3.2022, registered at Police Station Pachhad, District Sirmaur, Himachal Pradesh, under Sections 279, 337 and 338 of IPC and Section 187 of MV Act, on the basis of compromise, whereby parties have resolved to settle their dispute amicably inter-se them.

Though with a view to substantiate factum of compromise, petitioner has placed on record compromise deed, but with a view to ascertain genuineness and correctness of the compromise placed on record, this Court deems it fit to cause presence of respondent No.2 in the Court on the next date of hearing. Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes to cause presence of the petitioner as well as respondents No.2 on the next date of hearing, enabling this Court to pass appropriate orders.
