Petitioner seeks directions to respondents to include his family in the list of those eligible for employment under the Resettlement and Rehabilitation Plan, Parbati Hydro-electric Project, Stage-III District Kullu, H.P. and then to provide employment to the petitioner befitting his educational qualifications. The pleaded case of the petitioner is that Resettlement and Rehabilitation Scheme for the project affected families of Parbati Hydro-electric Project was notified on 27.04.2006; Petitioner's

family though eligible was not included in the project affected families and thus was deprived from employment; Despite representations preferred by the petitioner on 25.07.2016 (Annexure P-4), 16.03.2023 (Annexure P-5) and legal notice dated 04.01.2026 (Annexure P-6), the respondents have not as yet responded to the petitioner's requests.

3. In view of nature of grievance of the petitioner and considering the time factor involved in instituting this writ petition, it is deemed appropriate to dispose it of without examining merits thereof but with direction to respondent No.2/Competent Authority to consider the aforesaid representations of the petitioner in accordance with law and take appropriate call thereupon keeping in view the applicable scheme as also the impact of lapse of time period, if any, on the claim of the petitioner. In process of deciding the representations, due opportunity of hearing be given to all stake holders including the petitioner and respondents No. 3 & 4. The decision be taken within six weeks. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
