

**Kanta Devi versus Rakesh Kanwar & Others**

**COPC No.579 of 2026**

18.05.2026 Present: Mr. Prakash Sharma, Advocate, for the petitioner.

By way of the present application, a prayer has been made to punish the respondents for deliberate and willful disobedience of the judgment dated 17.09.2025, passed by this Court in CWP No. 4854 of 2024, titled as Kanta Devi versus State of H.P. & Others.

Vide judgment dated 17.09.2025, the Court has issued the following directions:-

*“4. In view of the decision in Bimla Devi and Kamna Ram, the petitioner has made out a case for grant of such directions. Accordingly, the respondents are directed to consider the case of the petitioner for counting Whole Time Contingent Service rendered by her w.e.f. 07.06.2008 to 02.07.2009 as qualifying service towards pension and pensionary benefits, in accordance with law and in light of above decisions within a period of six weeks. The order so passed be also communicated to the petitioner.”*

As per the stand taken by the petitioner, the said judgment has not been complied with.

In such situation, let show cause notice be issued to the respondents for **15<sup>th</sup> June, 2026**, calling upon them to explain, as to why the proceedings, under the Contempt of Courts Act, for intentional and willful disobedience of the judgment dated 17.09.2025, passed by this Court, be not initiated against them.
