Rohit Sharma vs. State of H. P. & Ors.

Present: Mr. Atul Jhingan, Advocate, for the petitioner.

Mr. Varun Chandel, Additional Advocate General, for the respondents.

Inter alia contends that fake driving licences have been issued and the beneficiaries are not even the residents of the said States and many are residents of Himachal Pradesh which would be clear from the Aadhar Cards which have been appended alongwith the driving licences. It is submitted that even a bare perusal of the driving licence (Annexure P-1) would go on to show that at one place it is mentioned that it is Indian Union Driving Licence, Madhya Pradesh, whereas the issuing authority is DTO Itanagar and the person, namely, Mukesh is a resident of Una, Himachal Pradesh and the licence number is mentioned as 'UP'. Similarly, while referring to the licence at page 26, it is pointed out that the driving licence is issued by the Government of Bihar, whereas the Asst. RTO, is mentioned as Sultanpur and the licence is shown as 'MH' which pertains to the State of Maharashtra and the person is a resident of Una. Reference is also made to Annexure P-3 (Page 35) to point out that Aadhar Card number of one Manjeet Singh, again resident of Una

is same and similar to the Aadhar Card number of Hardeep Kumar.

Keeping in view the above, we implead Superintendent of Police, Una also as respondent No. 5.

Notice. Mr. Varun Chandel, learned Additional Advocate General, appears and accepts, notice on behalf of the respondents.

It is made clear that in case any cognizable offence is made out, respondent No. 5 shall lodge an FIR and initiate investigation by constituting a Special Investigating Team headed by Senior Police Officer at the earliest, without waiting for the outcome of the Court proceedings.
