This writ petition has been filed for grant of  
 following substantive reliefs:-

“a. That a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No. 1 & 2 not to eject or demolish the premises of the petitioner i.e., Shop No.53, Jail Road, Mandi, District Mandi, H.P.

b. Issue a writ of mandamus directing respondents No. 1 & 2 to follow the principle of natural justice and provide the petitioner with the reasons of eviction/demolition of Shop No.53, Jail Road, Mandi, District Mandi, H.P. and further affording an opportunity to the petitioner to present his stance to the respondents.

c. That the record of the said premises i.e. Shop No.53, Jail Road, Mandi, District Mandi, H.P. may be called for.”

**3.** Granting such liberty, petition is disposed of as withdrawn. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
