



**Pankaj Sharma vs. State of Himachal Pradesh and others**

By way of instant petition filed under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, prayer has been made on behalf of the petitioner for quashing of FIR No.6 of 2026, dated 10.01.2026, under Sections 281 and 125(a) of Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita, registered at police Station, Palampur, District Kangra, Himachal Pradesh as well as consequent proceedings pending in the competent Court of law, on the basis of amicable settlement arrived inter se parties.

Though, compromise placed on record suggests that the parties have resolved to settle their dispute amicably inter se them, but this Court with a view to ascertain the correctness and genuineness of the compromise placed on record, deems it fit to summon respondent Nos. 2 and 3 for the next date of hearing, so that factum with regard to compromise placed on record, is ascertained.

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respondent Nos. 2 and 3 on the aforesaid date. In the meanwhile, learned Additional Advocate General also to ascertain the aforesaid factum.
