3. *Inter alia* contends that the three FIR's were registered against the petitioner and the last FIR was registered on 20.04.2025 on the basis of which the detention order has been passed on 02.05.2026 (**Annexure P-2**). It is also submitted that almost a period of eleven months has gone after registering the last FIR, and therefore, the proximate link is missing.

4. Counsel for the petitioner has placed reliance upon the judgment of this Court passed in Cr.WP No.31 of 2025, titled ***Ankush Thakur Vs. The State of Himachal Pradesh and Others***, decided on 26.02.2026 in support of his arguments.

5. Issue Notice. Mr. Arsh Rattan, learned Deputy Advocate General, appears and waives service of notice on behalf of the respondents-State. He prays for time to file reply by the next date.

6. Accordingly, the proceedings are deferred for **16.06.2026.**
