Learned counsel representing the parties submit that the relief claimed in the present petition is squarely covered by the judgment dated 17.07.2014 passed in **CWP No.3050 of 2014**, titled, **Nek Ram vs. State of Himachal Pradesh and others** and in view of this, the petitioner shall be content in case a direction is given to the respondents to

consider his claim, strictly as per the law laid down in the
aforementioned judgment and release his retiral benefits.

4. Learned counsel representing the respondents is
not averse to the said prayer made by the petitioner.

5. In view of the above, the respondents are directed
to release the retiral benefits due and admissible to the
petitioner, within six months from today and pay statutory
interest on the arrears and in case the same are not released
within six months from today, the respondents-Corporation
shall pay interest @9% per annum till its actual payment.

6. The present petition is allowed in the aforesaid
terms. Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
