

Rohit Chaudhary, vs. Shyam Lal

It appears from the judgment of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Court No.1 (learned Trial Court) that the complaint was dismissed on the ground that there is no stamp of presentation by the bank of the accused as well as the memo of the bank of the accused on record.

It has been submitted on behalf of complainant that the cheque was issued through Cheque Truncation System (CTS) and the cheque is not physically signed to the bank of the accused and this fact requires thorough consideration.

Let notice be issued to the respondent, returnable within a period of four weeks, on taking steps within a period of one week.

In the meantime, record of the learned Trial Court be requisitioned.
