The appellant/applicant has filed the instant application for placing on record list of persons whose cases were compounded by the respondent and the details of the same have been appended as Annexure A-1 with the application which shows that cases of 15 persons were compounded by the Cantonment Board, Subathu.

Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the respondent has drawn the attention of this Court to the instructions dated 22.06.2026 whereby it has been stipulated that the relief granted in the said cases, as cited by the appellant/applicant is not applicable in the present case as it involves encroachment over the government land in addition to unauthorized construction.

The Executive Officer, Cantonment Board, Subathu, is directed to remain present in the Court on the next date along with entire record in order to establish and show that why the similar relief which has been granted to

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the similarly situated persons, as mentioned in Annexure A-1, appended with this application, cannot be granted to the present appellant/applicant.
