prayed for the following reliefs:-

*“(i). That the Respondents may kindly be directed to pay all consequential financial benefits to the Petitioner in view of the Office Order No. PW/NBT/CB/Pay Fixation/2021-22-8636-39; dated 05/09/2022, issued by Respondent No.3, whereby pay of the Petitioner has been refixed in compliance to the Office Order No. PWE-74-15(A)(WC)ES-III/2022-5239-5338; dated 08/07/2022 issued/passed by Respondent No.2 while allowing the representation of the Petitioner for up-gradation as*

*Technical Grade-1 (Work Inspector) including :- (a) The entire arrears of revision of pay scale w.e.f. 01.08.2018 up to the date of retirement alongwith interest @ 12% per annum from the due date till the date of its realization; (b) The entire arrears of revised pension from the date of retirement till date of its realization alongwith interest @ 12% per annum and; (c) Revised gratuity and revised commutation value of pension to the Petitioner alongwith interest @ 12% per annum w.e.f. the date of retirement till the date of its realization.”*

2. Learned Counsel for the parties inform the Court that similar matters are pending adjudication before the Hon'ble Division Bench by way of CWP No. 8504 of 2025, titled as Madhu Deshta and others vs. State of Himachal Pradesh and others and connected matters.

3. Accordingly, this writ petition is disposed of with the direction that the adjudication by Hon'ble Division Bench in above matter shall be binding upon the parties herein and the parties shall abide by the final outcome thereof. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, also stand disposed of accordingly.
